- Psalm 24:1 The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;


#### #2 Sin



### #3 Redemption

- > The mission of God is 'to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven' (Col 1:20)
- > God's chosen intermediary is Jesus comes to declare the "good news of the kingdom of God." Luke 4:43
- > God's Primary vehicle is the Church; Eph 5:25 as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her
- > God has given His church a variety of gifts to complement each other in the ministry of equipping it to fulfill its mandate for the glory of Christ (Ephesians 4:11-13);
- > For we are God's handiwork created in Christ Jesus to do good works' (Eph 2:10)

> Therefore, we must at all times verbally invite unbelievers to saving faith in Jesus Christ  
Rom. 10:13-15 **13** for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” **14** How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? **15** And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”

## SLIDE 4

**#4 Restoration:** What fuels our motivation to see people and everything in the earth redeemed to Christ?

- Matthew 22:36-39 **36** “Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?” **37** Jesus replied: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’**38** This is the first and greatest commandment. **39** And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.
- **1) The Greatest Commandment:**
- Matthew 28:18-20 **18** Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **19** Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”
- **2) The Great Commission**
- The combination of these two is known in Missions as: Integral Mission

> As a church we have to be rooted in the knowledge that in seeking to fulfill this mandate, we recognize that our enablement does not depend on human criteria such as wealth, education, experience, and other attributes, but on the Holy Spirit (Zechariah 4:6);

> Our ministry be in partnership with the Holy Spirit and on his strength

> Therefore our ministry activities must be ins[pi]red by the Holy Spirit and rooted in and flow back into the local church.

> As Jesus did we are called to proclaim the good news to the poor and to glorify God in all we do;


Luke 4:18-19 **18** “The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, **19** to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.
