BIBLICAL BASIS FOR:
WHY WE SHOULD SHARE OUR FAITH

1) The CALL.

¹⁷ "Follow me," Jesus told them, "and I will make you fish for people."
Mark 1:7

2) The COMMAND.

¹⁹ Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

Matthew 28:19-20

Disciples are not spontaneously created when ONE comes to faith in Jesus; they are the product of a process involving other believers called discipleship.

⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Acts 1:8

Jesus didn't recommend that they become witnesses; He said THEY WILL BE WITNESSES.

3) The CHALLENGE.

²³ For ALL have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

4) The COMMITMENT.

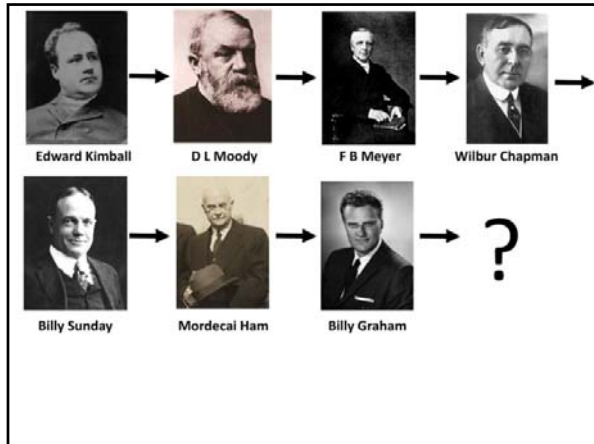
